

2021/2022 Dual Enrollment Process

Who Can Apply

- Junior/Senior high school standing
 - Students who a 3.0 cumulative high school GPA
 - Students must have permission from high school counselor/principal
 - No test requirement (USCB)



Admissions Application Process

- Student's Responsibility
 - Online Admissions Application
 - www.uscb.edu/apply Spring 2022 application (High School Concurrent)
 - Citizenship Verification Form
 - With copy of S.C. Driver's License or U.S. Birth Certificate
 - Immunization Form
 - With copy of shot records (MMR and Meningitis shot requirement)



Admissions Application Process

- Counselor's Responsibility
 - BCSD Dual Enrollment Permission Form
 - High School Transcript



Admissions Application Process

- Deadlines
 - Online Admissions Application: October 22, 2021
 - Supplemental Documentation: November 5, 2021
 - Includes: Permission Form, High School Transcript, Citizenship Verification Form/Identification, and Immunization Form/Records

Failure to meet the above deadlines may result in a withdrawal of your application.



Registration Process

- Meet with Counselor to complete Registration Worksheet
 - Review Available Classes for Spring 2022
- Attend Registration Session with Academic Advising
 - Registration Sessions will be held in November



Enrollment Process

- Register for Parking Decal
- Attend Orientation
 - An Orientation Session will take place in mid-December
- Pick Up Textbooks/Course Materials from Campus Bookstore
 - Textbook Pickup will take place in early January
