



Field Trip Medication Policy

If your student already has medication in the clinic, it will be sent on the field trip. All medications will be given by a designated staff member. If your student will need additional medication for the field trip, see our complete Medication Policy [here](#) and/or see the instructions below:

Prescription Medications: must be in their original prescription containers, currently dated and labeled with the name of the student and the medicine, prescribing physician, dosage to be given, and time(s) of day to be administered. A parent/guardian must bring the medicine to the clinic, along with the Prescription Medication Form completed and signed by the student's doctor and parent/guardian.

For Over-the-Counter Medications: a parent/guardian will need to complete and sign the Non-Prescription Medication Form and bring the form along with the medicine in the original container to the clinic.

All medications need to be brought to the clinic by a parent/guardian at least 24 hours prior to the departure time of the field trip

Only provide the amount of medication that is needed for the field trip

Additionally, students cannot carry medication themselves unless they have a self-carry form on file – see BPS medication policy.
